Also, many retail pharmacies sell special containers (e.g. envelopes) in which patients can mail unused medications to a licensed, secure facility where they are safely destroyed.

NOTE: The patient or their designated family member or caregiver can transfer their unused or expired medicines to the disposal drop off sites. Only legally registered or authorized sites for take back/disposal centers can receive the medicines. The individuals conducting the medicine review will not receive medicines for disposal, unless they are a registered site.
