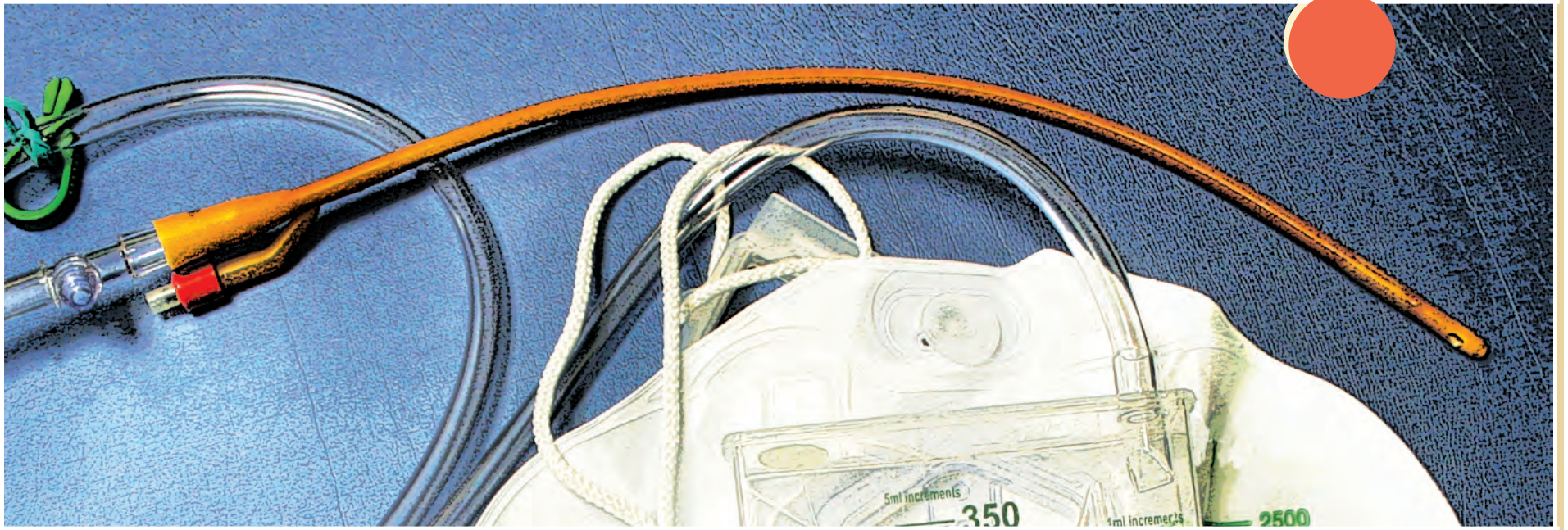


Why does your patient need that catheter?



Remember...

A urinary catheter is indicated only for:

- ✓ **Perioperative use in certain specified surgeries*;**
- ✓ **Accurate measurement of urinary output in critically ill patients (intensive care);**
- ✓ **Management of acute urinary retention or obstruction;**
- ✓ **Promoting healing of pressure ulcers in incontinent patients; or**
- ✓ **Improved patient comfort for end-of-life care.**

*Genitourinary surgeries, surgeries of prolonged duration, surgeries requiring large-volume infusions or diuretics, and surgeries requiring intraoperative monitoring of urinary output.
